



## Plant Information - Alternanthera 'Brazilian Red Hots'



### Information:

This spectacularly colored plant is perfect as a landscape edging plant, and is perfect for basing containers, tolerates partial shade, but the most vivid colors are produced in full sun. Small white flowers that can last for 3 months or more during the fall.

This variety was named a Texas Superstar in 2016.

**Exposure:** Full sun to partial shade
