Description:	An award-winning tropical perennial shrub most commonly used as a houseplant .		
Features:	Beautiful apricot-colored flowers that bloom April through October.		
Uses:	Small or large containers, combination pots, houseplant, landscape.		
pH:	5.8 - 6.2	EC 0.6 - 0.9	
Temperature:	65° - 72° Day and Night		
Light:	Full sun		
Irrigation:	Moderate, well-drained soils.		
Planting:	4" Pot	1 cutting	5 to 7 weeks

Pinching:	One pinch at transplant.		
Fertilization:	Feed with 20-10-20 at 150 - 200 ppm		
Regulators:	B-9 at 1500 - 2500 ppm
