Common Name:	Turnera <i>ulmifolia</i>		
Description:	Commonly called 'Yellow Alder', this variety is a dense, compact shrub that has dark green foliage and bright yellow flowers.		
Features:	This variety is a dense, compact shrub that is great in drought-stricken areas.		
Uses:	Gallon containers, areas with restricted water guidelines, combinations.		
pH:	5.8 - 6.2	EC	0.8 - 1.2
Temperature:	68° - 75° F Day	65° - 70° F	Night
Light:	High light		
Irrigation:	Suitable for areas with restricted water guidelines once established		
Planting:	4" Pot	1 cutting	7 to 8 weeks

Pinching:	One pinch when plant is well rooted in finished pot		
Fertilization:	Feed with 20 - 10 - 20 at 150 - 200 ppm
